- I. **Opening of Meeting**

 - B. Dr. Calevich volunteered to record minutes for the meeting

- II. **Approval of Minutes from November Meeting (Lazar)**
 - A. The minutes from November, 2019 and January, 2020 were reviewed. Cheryl Stopar mentioned a change Lisa Mollica made a motion to approve minutes and Marla Speeth seconded the motion
- III. **Updates**
 - A. Monthly Wellness Initiatives at BBHHS
 - i. Hallie spoke about Wellness Wednesdays. Cooking, music, fitness, healthy relationships are the themes of the activities. - B. Ohio Department of Health Grant Continuation – Lazar, Meluch, Paciorek
 - i. The Ohio Department of Health Grant Continuation will be taken on by Samantha Meluch and Steve Paciorek. She has worked on the grant for 21/2 years and will work two days per week on the grant and three days on groups in the middle and high school. Cessation and resources/services have been an important part of the grant. “My Life, My Quit” is a vaping cessation program that will be highlighted. Steve Paciorek will be focusing on adults in Brecksville and surrounding communities. Steve is a professor at Kent State in Public Health and will be involving college students in the project during their practicum.
- C. Tobacco Cessation at the High School
